Nu Phi Mu Sorority invites you to participate in its 32nd Annual Food & Gift Extravaganza, formally known as the Arts & Craft Fair, scheduled for November 21, 2009. Booth space is limited to 65 spaces. Please fill out the application form completely as it will be judged by our review panel.

Booths are offered in two sizes. Around the circle edge, booths are approximately 15' wide across the back and 13' wide across the front and 9' deep. The other booths are approximately 9' wide by 14' deep. All booths have approximately the same square footage. (Diagram available at <http://www.goodlandnet.com/crafftair>). Booth prices are \$45. Two booths, side-by-side can be purchased. Electricity is available for an additional \$5 per exhibitor (please provide your own extension cords). One table will be provided for a \$5 fee; any extra tables will be available for \$5 per table on a first come basis. No subleasing or resale of space is permitted.

Please check in at the reception table to receive your booth assignment and packet. Booth set up will be Friday night at 8:30 p.m. MST-NO EARLIER. Nu Phi Mu requires time to cover the floor, mark booths, etc. after the sports practices conclude. The building will be open for set up until 11:00 p.m. MST that evening. Saturday morning set up will begin at 6:30 a.m. MST. Anyone closing down early will not be permitted in future shows.

This is a juried show. PLEASE enclose pictures of the crafts and display set up, if available. Your pictures will be returned. You will be notified of your acceptance by October 1st upon receipt of your registration form and money.

HANDCRAFTED products, MANUFACTURED products, BUSINESS DISPLAYS, and FOOD ITEMS not meant for immediate consumption or that do not compete with the lunch counter, like jellies, WILL BE ACCEPTED. Applications and photos, which do not clearly describe the product, will be denied. Decisions shall be at the sole discretion of the Nu Phi Mu Sorority Ways & Means Committee.

The exhibitor must furnish all display materials. Tables must be covered on 4 sides to the floor. Booths must be maintained in a neat and orderly fashion and the area left in clean condition at the end of the show. Free assistance will be available for unloading and loading. Additionally, Nu Phi Mu runs a lunch counter featuring sloppy joes, nachos, and homemade cinnamon rolls.

Exhibitors are responsible for collecting Kansas Sales Tax. The Kansas Department of Revenue requires a report be sent listing the names of each vendor from the show. The tax rate for Goodland is 7.55%. If you need information on obtaining a Kansas Sales Tax number, please indicate this on your application.

Payment must accompany reservation form. If all spaces are filled, we will return your check and put your name on a waiting list. Exhibitor cancellations prior to November 1, 2008 will receive a refund.
